## Training & Education

**Recovery Coach Academy** is a 46-hour training that combines the key concepts and fundamental skills of the strengths-based approach needed to become a Peer Recovery Specialist or volunteer recovery coach.

**Continuing Education** is offered to Peer Recovery Specialists maintaining certification, and to anyone in recovery looking to strengthen skills as a Recovery Coach or a person in recovery.

### **Recovery Outreach**

MRC volunteers bring an in-depth educational presentation to your organization, sharing recovery resources and support services offered through MRC and elsewhere.
